The Academy of Fine Arts in Mainz is the only art academy in Rhineland-Palatinate. It offers Diplom/Meisterschüler degrees in Fine Arts, and Bachelor/Master degrees in Fine Arts Education. The Art Academy is characterized by its concentration on artistic disciplines and practice, as well as a high degree of collegiality, flexibility and interdisciplinary exchange.

The central role of the professor is to lead a class in "Film and Time Based Art" for students of Fine Arts and Visual Arts Education. The focus of the class will be on Film as a fine arts medium, encompassing historical and contemporary developments in the field of film. The successful candidate is expected to have contributed substantially to the field of film in contemporary art in the contexts of museums, film festivals, cinema and/or exhibitions, with an artistic practice spanning analogue and digital production.

The successful applicant will have a master's degree from a relevant art academy/university, and/or an exceptional career and artistic practice, university/academy level teaching experience, as well as a willingness to take part in the academy's various structures of self-governance, including committees and administrative procedures.

In addition, applicants must meet the conditions for recruitment required by § 49 Hochschulgesetz Rheinland-Pfalz.

The state of Rhineland-Palatinate and the Johannes Gutenberg University place great importance on student support and advising and therefore expect a high level of attendance of lecturers.

The Academy of Fine Arts in Mainz values the diversity of its staff and professors. Applicants with disabilities who are suitably qualified will be given preferential consideration. Applications by artist duos will be accepted. The successful applicant will also potentially be appointed as a civil servant. Interviews and lectures are expected to take place on June 8th and 9th, 2020.
